ABSTRACT

The objective of this research was examining empirically the effect of the board's budget knowledge, the public participation, the public policy transparency, and the public accountability on the regional financial supervision. The subject of this research was the board of legislative assembly. The type of the data of this research was the primary data in the form of the respondent perceptions.
