In implementing information systems, companies need good planning so that the implementation carried out can run in accordance with the company's existing business strategy so that it can provide contribution to the clinic in competition between other business people. To solve problems and provide recommendations for the Rumbia Medical Clinic, the phenomena that occur in the field will be recorded and analyzed using the SWOT and Porter's Five Force methods to determine the strategic position for the Rumbia Medical Clinic which will later be used as a basis for creating a business strategy that can be used to increase competitiveness. The next process carried out is to reformulate the clinic's strategy taking the basis of the SWOT analysis. This research then resulted in strategic planning for the next 5 years and the development of information technology that can be implemented by the Rumbia Medical Clinic in the future.
