THE INFLUENCE OF ORGANIZATIONAL COMMITMENT, USE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND CORPORATE GOVERNANCE MECHANISM ON GOVERNMENT PERFORMANCE ACCOUNTABILITY

(Study at West Pesisir Regency OPD)

ABSTRACT

This research aims to determine the influence of 4 independent variables, namely Organizational Commitment, Information Technology, Corporate Government Mechanisms, on government performance accountability. The sampling method used is the purposive sampling method, namely selecting samples using criteria. The respondents of this research were representatives of Regional Apparatus Organizations (OPD) in Pesisir Barat Regency, namely the Investment and Integrated Services Department, the Organizational Section of the Regional Secretariat and the Regional Financial and Asset Management Agency of Pesisir Barat Regency. The data collection technique in this research used a questionnaire method which was distributed to 3 agencies so that the sample was 48 people. Based on the data that has been collected and the tests that have been carried out on the problems in this research, using the multiple linear regression method, the following conclusions can be drawn: Based on the table at the conclusion of this thesis which shows a significance probability of <0.05, it can be concluded that Organizational Commitment, Information Technology and Corporate Governance Mechanisms simultaneously have a significant positive effect on government performance accountability. OPD that is aware of the importance of the influence of the variables explained above will carry out its accountability performance well and transparently.
