The purpose of the study was to find out the effect of the role of village apparatus, competence of village fund management officials, organizational commitment of village government, and the utilization of information technology on the accountability of village fund management (a case study in Gunung Agung TulangBawang District). The population in this study was all village apparatus working in 13 village government offices located in Gunung Agung TulangBawang Barat District. The sample in this study consisted of 65 village apparatus roles. The sampling technique used in this study was purposive sampling. The data analysis methods included descriptive statistics, instrument testing, classic assumption testing, multiple linear regression analysis, and model feasibility testing. This research used SPSS version 25. The result of the study indicated that the role of village apparatus, competence of officials, organizational commitment of village government, and the utilization of information technology significantly affected the accountability of village fund management.
