This study aims to prove empirically the effect of Earning Performance, the Proportion of Local Own Revenue and General Allocation Funds in all districts / cities in Sumatra. The type of data used in this study is a secondary data source. Data collected through the mechanical documentation method, namely with the help of a machine to provide data with a record of events without the physical presence of the researcher on the object of research. This research was conducted with visits to the 2018 LKPD and DJPK KEMENKEU portals. The number of samples used in this study were 120 samples from all districts / cities in Sumatra. This research was conducted using descriptive statistics, classical assumption test and multiple linear regression with a 95% confidence level. The results of this study indicate that the Earning Performance, the Proportion of Regional Original Income and the General Allocation Fund have an effect on the regional independence of districts / cities in Sumatra
